

Introducing Return to Practice for General Practice Nursing

What is it?

An option for nurses with a lapsed NMC registration to return to work in a primary care setting

Who is it for?

Any nurse with a lapsed NMC registration and the relevant skills or experience who would like to return to work in primary care within the North East, North Cumbria & Yorkshire region

How does it work?

Returning nurses will undertake a short academic programme at Northumbria University that will also include a clinical placement (of 450 hours) with a local primary care provider. This will also include access to the Discovering a Nursing Career in General Practice module.

What funding is available from NHS England?

A returnees tuition fees are fully funded and they will be able to receive a £1000 bursary (unless they are employed on an NHS contract during the course). Placement providers will also be able to claim a placement tariff. Further details can be provided by the regional Return to Practice lead (see contact details below).
