

# NHSE WTE Primary Care Directorate (YH) Introduction to Clinical Supervision Skills



This is a fully funded virtual half day introductory course that will equip attendees with basic skills and knowledge to undertake clinical supervision in the workplace.

This course is intended for clinicians and non-clinicians in the Yorkshire and Humber region working in primary and community care environments from the wider workforce professions and GPs who wish to explore how to support their staff better without committing to becoming a GP Trainer.

The aims of the course are:

- To explore clinical supervision, it's role and function

- To understand how reflective questions can support clinical supervision
- To understand accountabilities and responsibilities of the clinical supervisor and supervisee
