Length: 12 months, part time

Start Date: September 2026 and January 2027

Delivery: Blended delivery pattern (synchronous and asynchronous)

Mapped to the ACCEND Career Pathway, Core Cancer Capabilities in Practice (CiP) and Education Framework, 2023.

The course aims to develop knowledgeable and capable practitioners in cancer, its treatments and care of people affected by cancer to provide high standards of complex care for patients using enhanced levels of critical judgement and skills to meet the challenges of contemporary and future cancer care.

This course provides learners with the knowledge, skills and leadership attributes to act as enhanced clinical practitioners within the profession and promote a culture that embraces care, compassion and safe, service user centered care that is based on best evidence.

The course is aimed at registered nurses and allied health professionals. Inter-professional and shared learning is embedded within the course to prepare learners for practice and their role within the wider health care team.

The course is a blended delivery approach to support a National / Regional reach of students.

Modules include:

- Principles of Integrated Practice in Cancer Care (level 7 20 credits)
- Advanced Physical Assessment and Disease Management Skills (level 7 20 credits)
- Advancing Learning, Leadership and Improvement (level 7 20 credits)
